Star Wars: Where Science Meets Imagination is the first exhibit of its kind that combines costumes and props from all six *Star Wars* films with real-world technologies, video interviews with filmmakers, scientists and engineers, and two large Engineering Design Labs, where visitors can build and test speeders and robots. Visitors will explore prototypes, learn about the engineers and designers who are creating new technologies, and discover intriguing similarities between how scientists and filmmakers think.

Things You Should Know Before Your Visit

- **Photography**, sketching, and strollers are permitted inside the exhibit.
- **Masks** may **not** be worn inside the exhibit.
- **Food**, drink, or disruptive behavior are not allowed inside the exhibit.
- **Star Wars Airchair Ride requirements:** Guests must be at least 5 years old and at least 42 inches tall to ride. No open-toed shoes or sandals are permitted.
- **Remember** to wear close-toed shoes (no sandals) to ride the Hovercraft and other Science Center attractions including the High-Wire Bike and Climbing Wall
