The California Science Center wants all of our guests to have the best possible experience. Consider visiting us during non-peak times. Non-holiday weekday afternoons (after 1:30 pm) are the least crowded days at the California Science Center.

2. Plan at least four hours to visit the California Science Center and *Star Wars*: Where Science Meets Imagination.

Most visitors take about an hour to go through the exhibit. Be sure to explore the Science Center's permanent, interactive galleries to complete your experience! For an "Out of This World Experience", visit the <u>Sketch Foundation</u> <u>Gallery Air and Space Exhibits</u>.

## Things You Should Know Before Your Visit

- **Photography**, sketching, and strollers are permitted inside the exhibit.
- Masks may not be worn inside the exhibit.
- **Food,** drink, or disruptive behavior are not allowed inside the exhibit.
- Star Wars Airchair Ride requirements: Guests must be at least 5 years old and at least 42 inches tall to ride. No open-toed shoes or sandals are permitted.
- **Remember** to wear close-toed shoes (no sandals) to ride the Hovercraft and other Science Center attractions including the High-Wire Bike and Climbing Wall
